Florida Financial aid professionals are actively implementing legislative changes. Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Updates are provided on the Office of Student Financial Assistance (OSFA) website at: www.FloridaStudentFinancialAidsg.org.

Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program:

- Beginning in the fall 2021 semester, Bright Futures Florida Medallion Scholarship (BFFMS) students enrolled in an associate degree program at a Florida College System (FCS) institution will receive 100 percent of tuition and specific fees. Upon completing an associate degree, the student may use his or her award to pursue a baccalaureate degree and receive 75 percent of tuition and specific fees.
- Students will be evaluated based on official test scores from the FDOE repository. To ensure OSFA obtains official test scores: Ensure demographics on your test registration and high school transcript match; and request your official test scores be sent to one of Florida’s 12 state universities when registering for the ACT®/SAT®.
